



SITE SAFETY & SECURITY MEASURES DURING CONSTRUCTION

With each project, the AAPS Capital Program's objective is to transform the student learning experience with the goal of providing for the health, safety, and well-being of all students in high-quality, equitable, and environmentally sustainable schools.

Best practices are utilized to limit learning disruptions during the school year. Opportunities will be made available to our students to showcase the construction work through safe, supported educational activities, in coordination with school building staff and administrators.

Site Safety & Security Measures

- All construction areas within the school will be separated by a temporary partition, preventing student and staff access to the construction area
- Where applicable, any work within the school will be under negative pressure helping ensure air quality within the school
- Outdoor barricades/barriers 8' tall with mesh fabric fence post driven into ground
 - o Additional barricades between temporary walkways and playgrounds
- Rolling gates at entrances
- Construction spotter for material delivery where crossing sidewalks
- Site security camera during duration of construction
- Reduce construction site access during school arrival and dismissal times
- Dust control will be in effect on site to minimize dust migration
- Construction hours will abide by City of Ann Arbor noise ordinance
- Lighting for construction areas
- Clear site construction signage
- All workers go through site specific safety program prior to working on site
- All workers will have a background check prior to working on site
